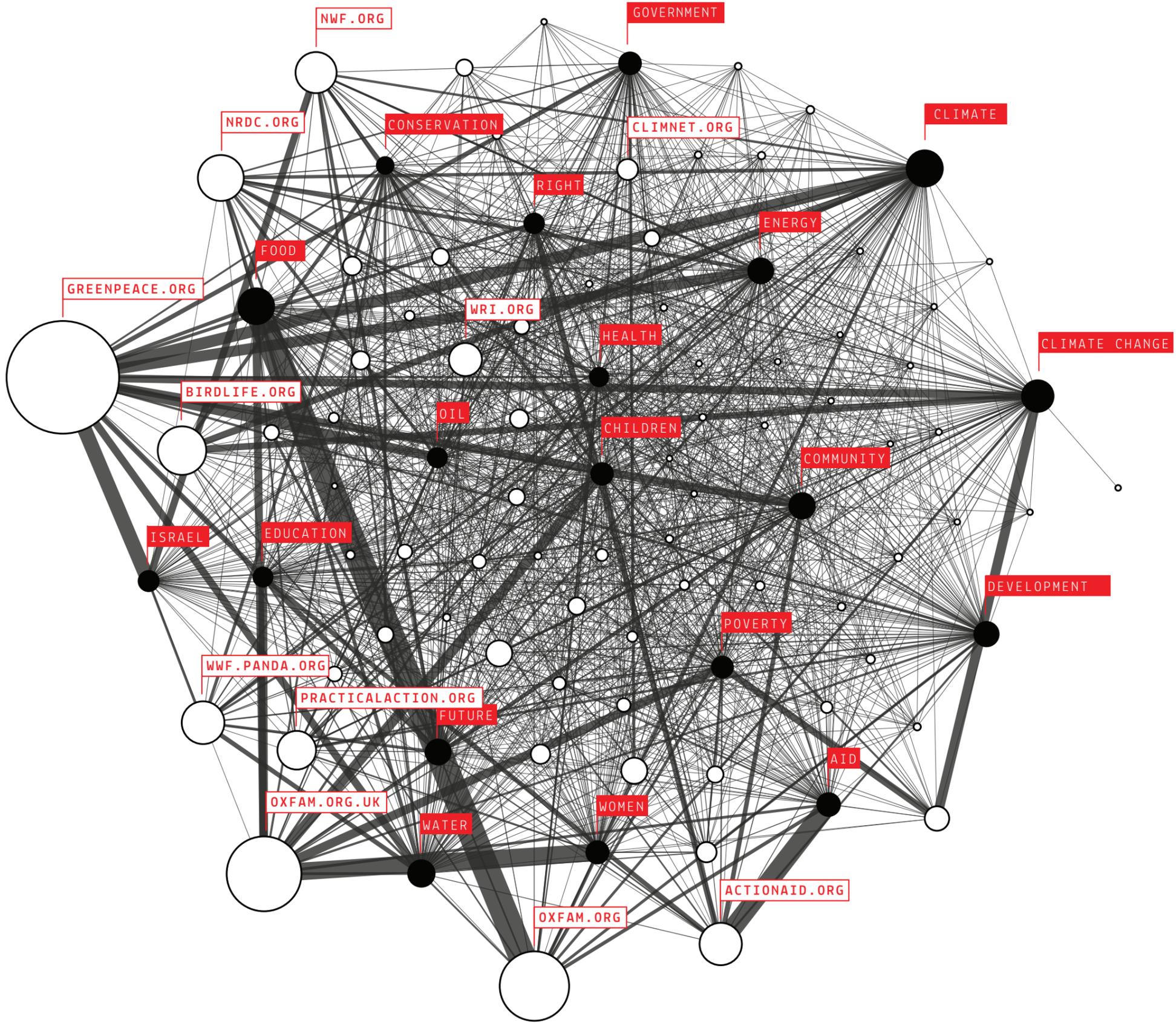

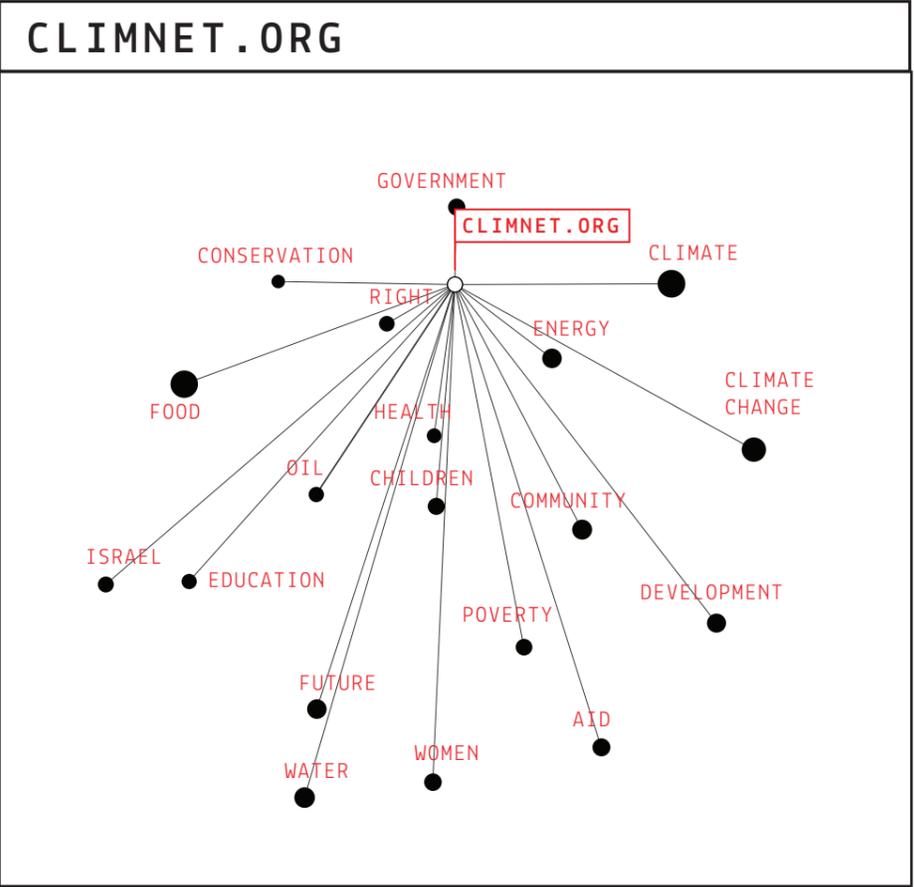
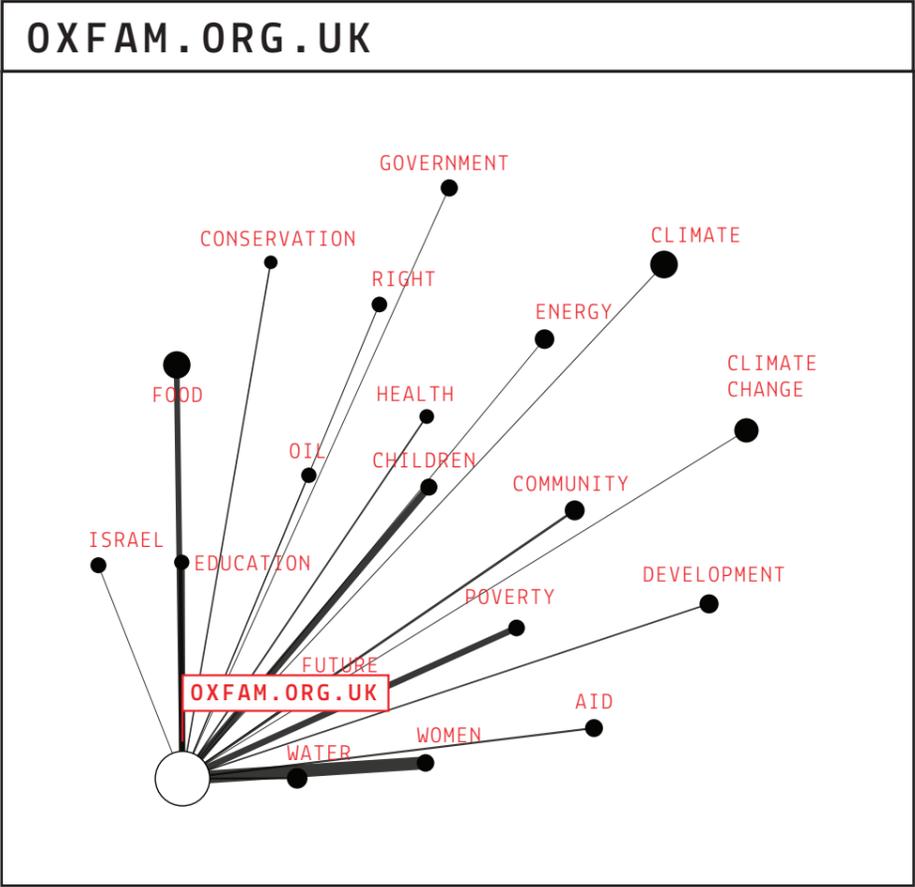
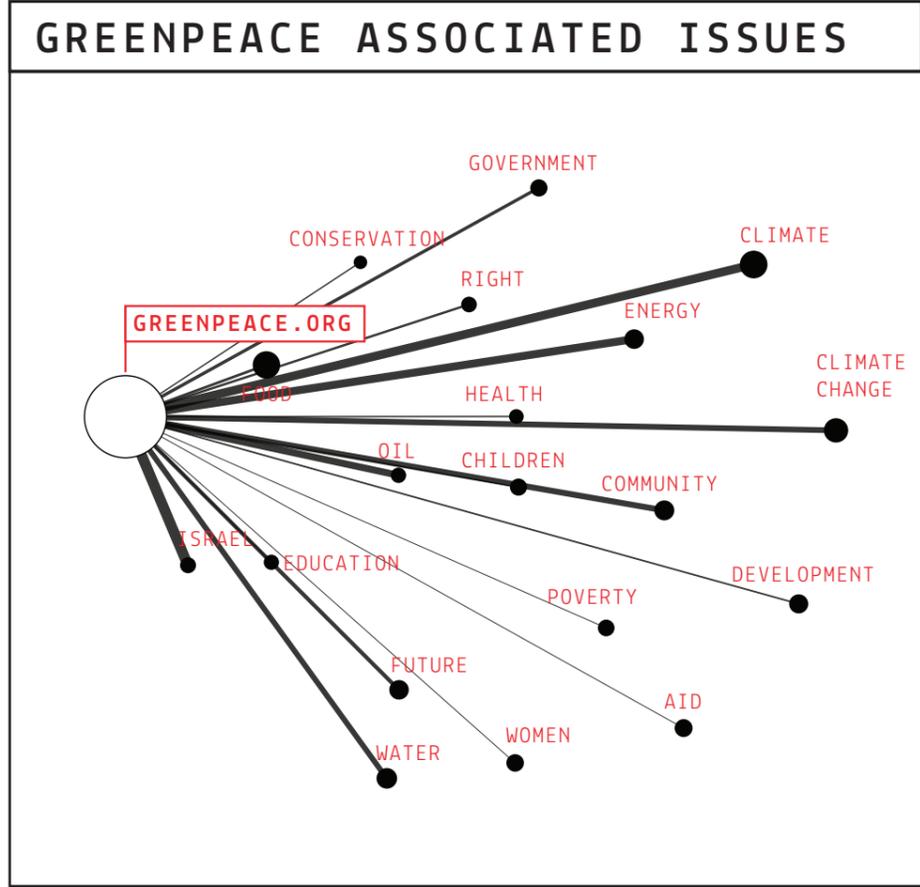

A list of 74 NGO websites was created based on shared members between the Climate Action Network and TCKTCKTCK. Searching manually through the NGO's missions and agendas delivered 279 issues. By testing the resonance of the issues, an issue agenda with main issues, sub-issues and main actors was created. The network graph shows the relations between issues (red) and NGO's (white). Circle size represent total issue frequency. Line thickness represents issue frequency of the issue in the site. Greenpeace encompasses most of the issues and features the most salient issues such as food, climate and water.
